"You have heard that it was said, You shall love your neighbour and hate your enemy." But I say to you, Love your enemies and pray for those who persecute you, so that you may be sons of your Father who is in heaven. For he makes his sun rise on the evil and on the good, and sends rain on the just and on the unjust. For if you love those who love you, what reward do you have? Do not even the tax collectors do the same? And if you greet only your brothers, what more are you doing than others? Do not even the Gentiles do the same? You therefore must be perfect, as your heavenly Father is perfect."

St. Matthew 5:43-48

For two years now, we have heard ongoing debate in the world and within Christendom regarding many issues surrounding COVID 19. We don't need to agree with their opinion. And in love we can voice our thoughts and convictions. However, Jesus does not give us the right to hate others for not listening to us and not agreeing with us on everything.

This goes also for our sharing about life concerns with others, whether Christians or not. That is not easy for our convictions regarding life run deep. It can be difficult, for example, to discuss abortion with someone who believes that abortion is regrettable, but necessary tool for woman in economical dire straits, or whatever other reason given for being in favour of killing the unborn. All too often such people insist on dodging the issue of who is that person in the womb and the

protection they should be given. Though losing our temper and putting a large dose of barbed language in our retorts may make the sinner in us feel better in the short run, have we accomplished what we hoped for? Jesus also said in the Sermon on the Mount, "turn the other cheek." (St. Matthew 5:39)

Jesus, as He hung on the cross, endured the sharp barbs of the leaders of the Jews who had convicted Him to death, as well as those of other bystanders. Yet, He prayed that His heavenly Father would forgive them. Thankfully, the forgiveness He won on the cross was not just for those who hurled barbs at Him in hate, but also for those who bear His name, when they hurl nasty invectives, or just think hateful thoughts, against those who don't listen to them.

I pray that you will find in this issue of our newsletter more helps in sharing in love what Scripture teaches on the sanctity of life from the womb to the tomb.

Ernest Hemingway, in his novel *The Sun Also Rises*, has this exchange between two characters, Bill Gorton and Mike Campbell: "How did you go bankrupt?" Bill asked.

Many people wonder how our culture has sunk to such low levels as it has, with the attack on the sanctity of human life, the way many look at unborn babies as disposable, the acceptance by some of physician-assisted suicide and euthanasia, and of course, the everincreasing attacks on traditional marriage and gender identity as male and female, as God created them.

How did this all happen? Of course, the answer is: Gradually, and then suddenly.

For years and years, those who oppose God and His Word have chipped away at such values as the right to life and traditional marriage and family structure. Then, in swift blows, things came tumbling down suddenly. And many are dazed and wonder how it could all happen so quickly.


